We offer Retinal Imaging to enhance services we provide. The advanced, sophisticated instrument allows us to see and keep a digital record of the inside of your eye this includes the retina, optic nerve, and the surrounding area which contains blood vessels. Viewing this can help us in the early detection of many eye diseases such as macular degeneration, cancer, diabetic retinopathy, glaucoma, hypertension, and retinal detachment. Previously only dilation could detect these eye diseases, but now with retinal imaging we have a non-invasive way of looking for them, which is easy on the patient and offers us more detail.

As your eye doctor I recommend retinal imaging for everyone especially if you have a history of diabetes, headaches, migraines, flashers or floaters, recent change in vision or a family member who has glaucoma diabetes or macular degeneration. The fee for this screening is \$35.00. If the screening exam detects any potential problems, we may recommend further tests or treatment.
